Dear HBC Family,

I recently shared with our church family some statistics on the way Americans view the authority and reliability of the Bible. I shared that

recent polls indicate that 20% of Americans believe that the Bible is the literal Word of God and that close to 1/3 of Americans believe the Bible is nothing more than a collection of fables, legends, history and moral precepts recorded by man. These numbers should be alarming to all Christians who hold the Bible dear to our hearts as the literal, inerrant and infallible Word of God. Over almost four decades I have been a student of God's Word and I am more convinced of its authority than at any other time in my life. The question that keeps rising in my heart is, "How can we maintain our commitment to the authority of God's Word when there is such an abundance of hostility toward God and His Word?" As I pondered an answer to this question, a few thoughts came to mind that I would like to share with you.

Dedication

Remaining dedicated to a cause is not very common anymore. Our society has affected Christians by offering to many cheap substitutes for absolute truth. If we are to remain dedicated to the truth of God's Word, we must be sure to consume a steady diet of the Bible daily. We cannot continue to remain truth to anything or anyone we do not commune with on a regular basis.

Determination

Christians must have a burning desire to remain determined to stand for the truth of God's Word even when it is unpopular to do so. It's easy to be determined to stand strong for the Lord when everything is going well in our lives. However, how will we respond when times are tough. God's Word is under attack from so many different factions and we must be determined to stand for its truth regardless of the cost.

Demonstration

We can be dedicated and determined to uphold the truth of God's Word, but it doesn't have any effect on the world until there is an outward demonstration of its effect on the way we live. When we study God's Word, we are given boldness to believe and the courage to be mobilized to proclaim its truth. We cannot be completely obedient to the Great Commission unless we are carrying the gospel beyond the walls to a waiting world in need of a Savior.

My prayer for our church family is that we will never compromise the truth of God's Word and that we will faithfully demonstrate the life changing power of the message of the gospel.
