In the Gospel of Mark, we read the story of a woman who was in a most dire situation when she found herself in the presence of Jesus.

### Mark 5:25-29 (NKJV)

25 Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years, 26 and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse. 27 When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment. 28 For she said, "If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well." 29 Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of the affliction.

There are several things about this particular lady and her situation that should touch all of us.

She was terminally ill.  
She was financially devastated.  
She knew Jesus was her only hope.

When we apply her situation to the world we live in, we can quickly see many others who are spiritually in this same situation. Sin has a way of damaging our lives, depleting our resources and causing us to live in despair. But, there is Hope and this Hope is found only in Jesus Christ. This poor lady demonstrated faith in Jesus' ability to heal her by simply reaching out to touch Him. Just one touch of the hem of His garment brought healing to her that could not be explained by medicine. Why? Because she experienced a miracle when she was in the presence of the Master!

Who might you be able to lead to Christ the only source of true healing?

Our country and our world needs healing from above. You and I have been given a deposit of the Word of God as well as new life through the blood of the Son of God. 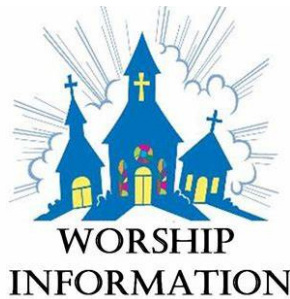

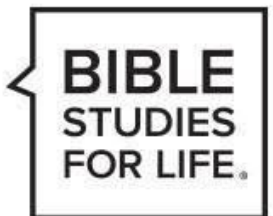
### WELCOME!
